The Crosby Scholarship Fund is established by the family and friends of US Army Captain Herbert C. "Herby" Crosby (deceased) in honor and memory of his selfless



dedication to the Nation. CPT Crosby died in a crash while serving as an Army helicopter pilot with the 1st Aviation Brigade during the conflict near Quang Nam province, Republic of Vietnam. CPT Crosby was listed as missing in action along with three other crewmembers in January 1970. His remains were officially



identified in 2006 and returned to the United States for interment.
